- Playing Times:** Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> January from 1pm – 4 pm. Followed by prizegiving and presentation of prizes. Finish 4:30pm.  
There is a maximum seating capacity of 60 so please make sure to book early.

Late entries will only be accepted if the maximum seating capacity of 60 has not been reached. An extra fee of \$5 will be charged.
